1. VISTA

Approximate profit school YTD is \$7100 including unrealized profit on existing inventory.

2. Snow Tubing Tail Gate Party

This event will take place at Horseshoe Valley Resort on Thursday, February 18 from 6 to 8 pm. The cost will be \$16 per individual for the two hours or \$60 for a family of four. Tickets will be available for sale through the Parent Council office until February 11th. After February 11 the tickets will only be available at the hill for a cost of \$20 per person for 2 hours. Hot chocolate and treats will be available during the event. A form will be sent out in the Thursday folder to try and confirm numbers. There is a height restriction of 42" in place for tube riders.

3. Bingo

We are planning to hold a bingo night in April. More details to follow.

4. Lunch

Term 3 lunch begins Monday, March 1. Term 2 lunches have been well received. Some days have between 90 and 100 children on the hot lunch program. The goal of this program is to provide a child friendly, high quality lunch within a \$5 price range. New forms for Term 3 lunches will be sent out in the Thursday folder by mid-February.

5. Innisbrook Gift Wrap

This program raised \$1225 for parent council. The goal for this fundraiser was to reach \$2000.

6. Holiday Fair

The Holiday Fair raised \$5730 for parent council. The goal was to raise between \$4500 and \$5000.

7. Mother's Day

This year will feature a garden craft. Children will have the opportunity to decorate a clay pot with their mother and each child will receive soil and seeds to plant in their pot at home. Light snacks and tea will be provided. We are aiming for \$10 per mother and child but cost is to be confirmed.

8. Wine and Cheese Tasting (previously known as "The Gala")

The event will be moved offsite to the MacLaren Art Gallery and will be held on Friday, May 7 at 7 pm. The evening will feature 7 tastings of different Vintages wines as well as a cheese table. There will be a silent and live auction with a dance following. There will also be some silent auction items put up in the school prior to the event for those unable to attend but wishing to participate in some of the silent auction items. The goal is to sell 300 tickets at an approximate cost of \$100 per ticket. Corporate and personal sponsorships will also be available at different price levels. Two main sponsors will be sought and they will have their company name etched on the wine glass that each attendee will receive at the door. Aiming for \$20 000 in corporate sponsorships for this event.

9. KBS Business Community Incentive Program

A few businesses within the KBS community have offered to provide an incentive to the school through other KBS family purchases. We will prepare a letter next week to send out to all families to determine if other businesses are interested in providing an incentive to KBS. A signup sheet will be created to include the company name, % incentive to KBS, and any restrictions or special notes. We will then provide a list of all interested businesses to the KBS community.
